NWT Resident Harvest

Current Resident Regulations:

- **Require hunting licence**
- **Maximum of 2 bull tags per year**
- **Season 15 Aug to 30 April**
- **G/BC/01, G/BC/03 & I/BC/05 only areas in Beaufort Delta region where residents can harvest barren-ground caribou**
 - **Only other Area open in NWT is U/BC/01 (Beverly Herd)**



NWT Resident Harvest

Harvest Data based on:

- Licensing system record of hunters/tags sold
- Mail-in (3 wave) resident survey (23/24 still in progress – 3 wave mail out)

- **Limited due to weather**



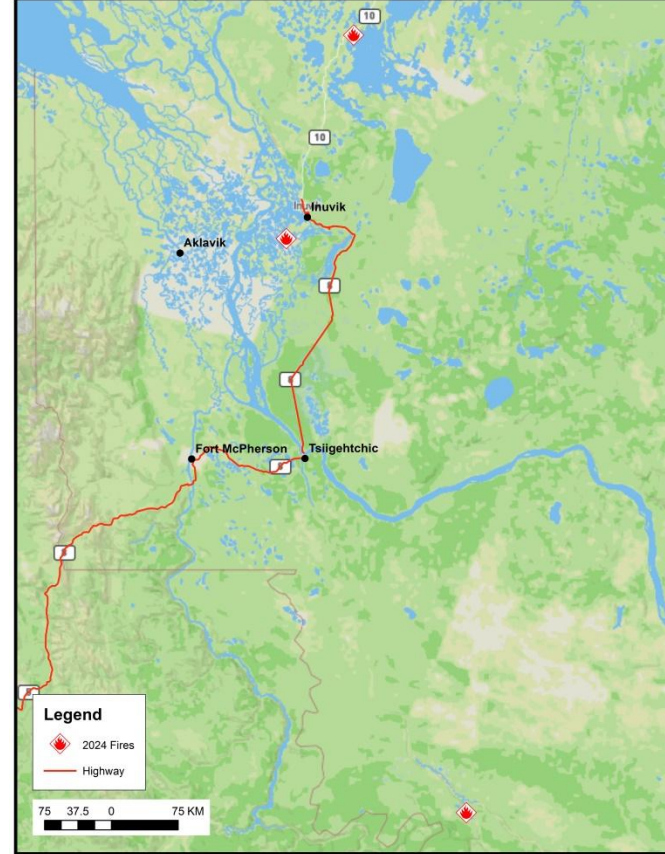
Body Condition Samples

- **9 sample kits collected in 23/24 season**



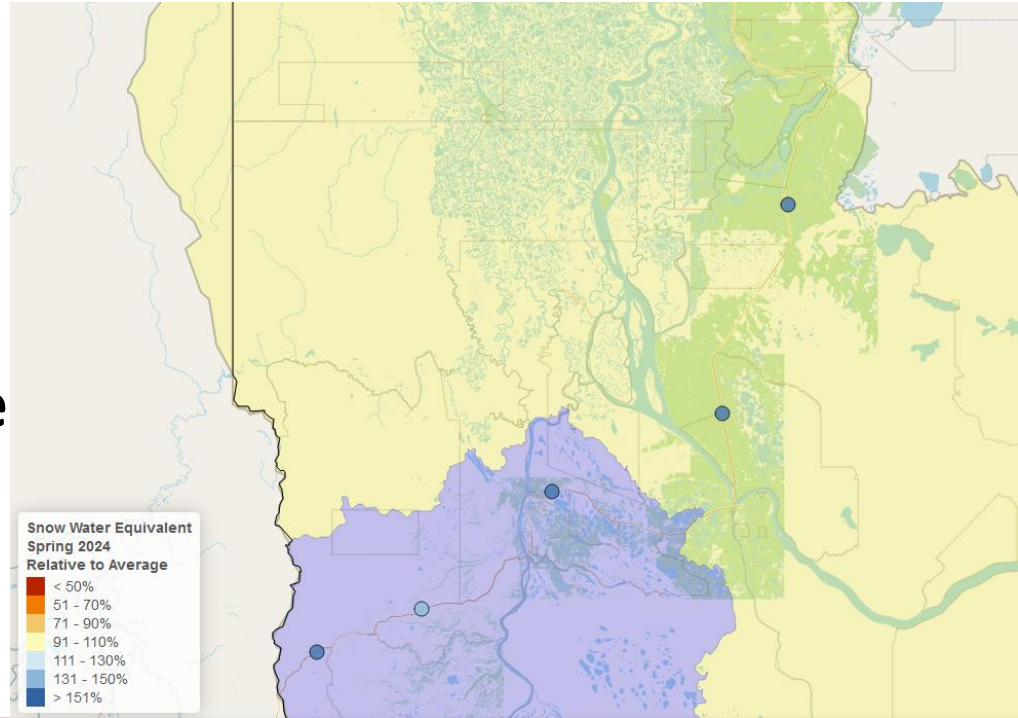
Habitat
